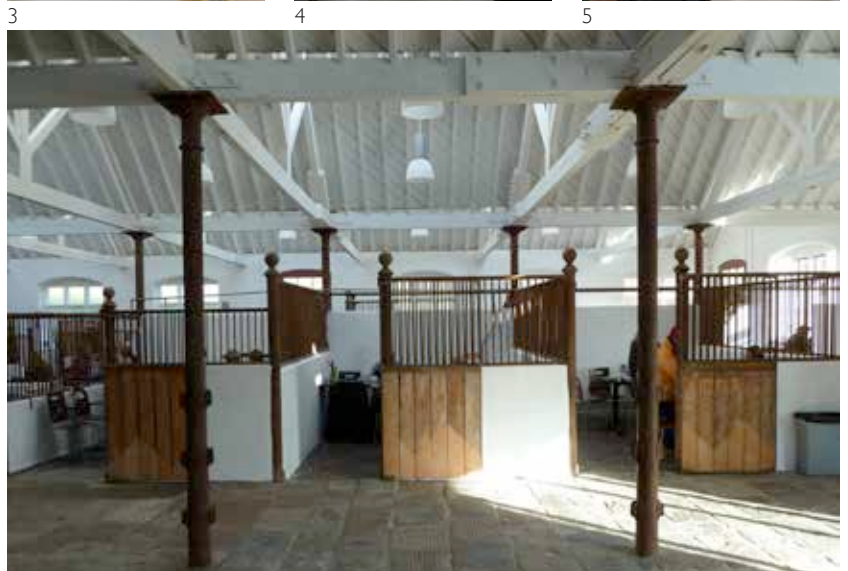
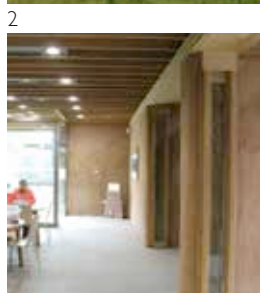


# TYNTESFIELD VISITOR FACILITY

HOME FARM, TYNTESFIELD, WRAXALL, SOMERSET



6 The original 1883 estate model farm has been converted into a visitor facility for the Tynesfield estate.

The main part of the complex was a large covered yard for the cattle, with an imposing geometrical roof structure. This now holds the restaurant and entrance space in a way that retains the qualities

7 and textures of the original farm building. The visitor reception is a straw bale structure that has been hidden within an old barn.
