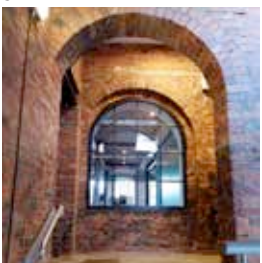

Redevelopment of the existing museum within the Grade II listed Slater's Mill to incorporate an additional floor for exhibits and new lift shaft. Construction of the 1990's Shires shopping centre had concealed the historic mill structure. This project has repaired and re-exposed the structure and simplified internal layouts to provide visual clarity and a sense of the original mill. Externally

a new independent lift extension provides full accessibility to all floors. This Town Council led project has support from the National Lottery Heritage Fund, Friends of Trowbridge Museum and several other organisations.
