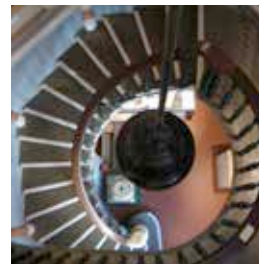

Redevelopment and extension of the Lyme Regis Museum included new gallery spaces, education room, visitor toilets, improved circulation, a shop, increased storage for collections and additional office space.

The intention was to reinforce the inward looking character of the original museum building, and

create a new extension that opened out to sea. A second phase is planned to reinstate the missing three storey east wing.
