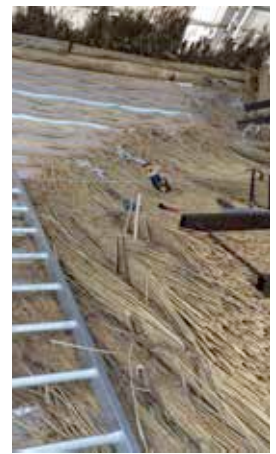


RING OF BELLS INN

North Bovey, Dartmoor



7 A 17th century Grade II listed Devon longhouse, of masonry, plastered cob and thatch that retained C15th & C16th features. Latterly converted to a public house, which suffered a catastrophic fire in 2016. A thorough analysis of the burnt out remains informed a sympathetic repair scheme to reconstruct a new roof and internal works. The pub has now been revived - to the delight of locals.
